£7.9 million consortium funded with UKaid from the UK Government from 1 May 2020.



THE PROBLEM

IO MILLION PEOPLE FELL ILL WITH TB IN 2019 56% MEN, 32% WOMEN, 12% CHILDREN



2.9 MILLION PEOPLE WERE NOT DETECTED OR OFFICIALLY NOTIFIED 1.4 MILLION PEOPLE DIED FROM THIS PREVENTABLE AND CURABLE DISEASE
